- Tossing coins into a magical wishing well



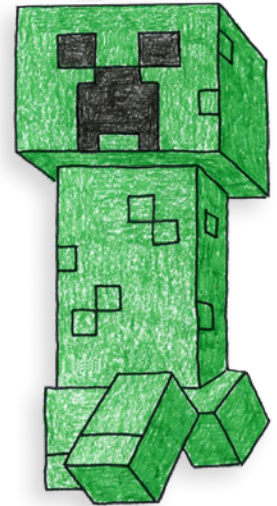
## 6. What is compound interest?
